# Update: What the latest Greater Brisbane restrictions mean for Queensland's tourism operators

Greater Brisbane's lockdown will end at 6:00pm AEST this evening, but some restrictions will remain, including wearing a mask. These restrictions continue to apply to people who have been in the Greater Brisbane region since 2 January 2021, no matter where they may have travelled to since.
