

Queensland community sentiment towards tourism and events

February 2021

Queenslanders strongly believe **tourism has a positive impact on their local community.**

Most Queenslanders consider it **important for Queensland to host events** and that the Queensland Government attract and secure events. **Queenslanders also see events as an important way for the community to 'get back to normal'** as COVID-19 restrictions are lifted.

Importance of events in Queensland

87% Believe it is important for the Queensland Government to support events once restrictions are lifted

86% Believe it is important for the Queensland Government to be involved in attracting and securing major events

85% Believe it is important for Queensland to host events

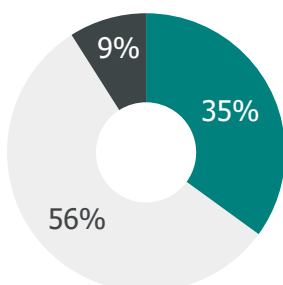

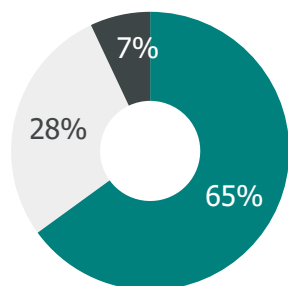
Impact of Tourism

90% Agree Tourism is good for the economy and is good for local business

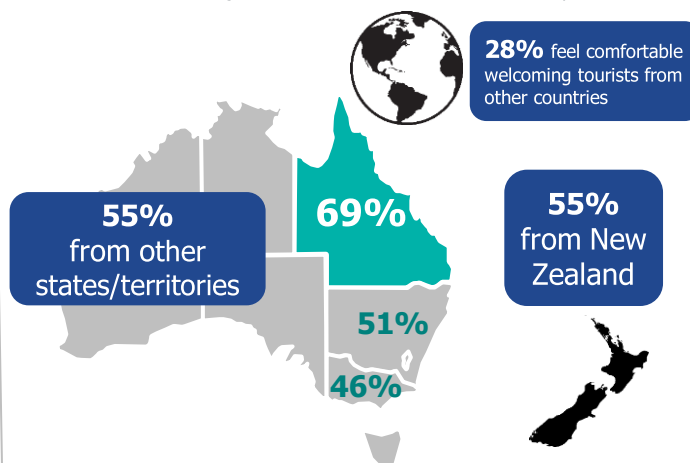
COVID-19 related impact
